Telangana State Council of Higher Education has collaborated with the British Council, Aberystwyth University, Bangor University (Welsh universities) and Osmania University, Kakatiya University to develop two innovative curricula i.e., Undergraduate Course in B.Com (Finance) and BA (HEP) aimed at preparing students for employment and to enhance their employability skills.

Prof. R. Limbadri, Chairman, Telangana State Council of Higher Education convened a meeting today i.e., 11.03.2024 at 11.00 am with the select **21** autonomous college Principals, Heads & chairman BOS of Osmania University for Commerce, History, Economics and Political Science and Senior Faculty of Commerce under the Jurisdiction of OU, KU, TU, SU, MGU, PU and Officials from office of CCE, in the conference hall of TSCHE for introduction of these innovative curricula.

Prof. D. Ravinder, Vice-Chancellor, Osmania University, Prof. U. Vijjulatha, Vice-Chancellor (I/c), Telangana Mahila Viswavidyalayam, Prof. Sriram Venkatesh, Secretary TSCHE, Prof. V. Usha Kiran, Director, Telangana Curriculum Project, addressed the meeting.

Prof. R. Limbadri ,Chairman, TSCHE stated that as a pilot project, the Undergraduate Course of B.Com (Finance) and BA (HEP) will be implemented from the A.Y 2024- 2025 in the select autonomous colleges

A detailed presentation on curricula, mapping of learning outcomes with the assessment methods and teaching strategy have been explained by Prof. V. Usha Kiran, Director, Telangana Curriculum Project

Prof. R. Limbadri, Chairman, TSCHE explained the need for future workshops (Faculty Development Programme (FDP)) which will be held by TSCHE for the two courses in four subjects i.e Commerce, History, Economics and Political Science. These workshops will orient the teaching faculty in taking the courses further.

He also invited the autonomous college principals, and faculty to participate in the online workshop scheduled by Aberystwyth University and Bangor University (Welsh universities) on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024 wherein elaborate the discussions for strengthening the curricula and teaching methodology will be held.
