Press Note - DOST-2022 Phase-II Seat Allotment

Prof.R.Limbadri, Convener DOST & Chairman, TSCHE and Sri. Navin Mittal, IAS, Commissioner, Collegiate Education & SPD-RUSA released the Phase-II seat allotments on DOST-2022-23.

Congratulating the students who got seat allotment, the Convener declared the following details of Phase-II and the schedule of Phase-III.

- 1. Total number of candidates allotted in Phase-II: **48,796** (39,390 from Phase-II & 9,406 from Phase-I, 5575 got betterment out of 9,406)
- 2. Total number of candidates who got seat allotment against Priority-I: 34,678
- 3. Total number of candidates who got seat allotment against Priority-II and other priorities: 14,118
- 4. Total number of candidates who exercised web-options but could not get seat allotment because of their limited choice of web-options: 3,809
- 5. Total number of candidates registered in Phase-II: 28,220
 - a. Aadhaar mobile linked OTP authentication: 23,581
 - b. T App Folio photo image authentication (TSBIE): 1,507
 - c. MeeSeva Biometric Authentication: 3,132
- 6. Total number of candidates who gave web-options in Phase-II, 2022: 52,605

Instructions to the candidates:

- i. The candidates who are allotted seats will get SMS to their registered mobiles. These candidates can also get seat allotment details, on demand, through WhatsApp.
- ii. All the candidates who secured a seat are instructed to reserve their seat through Online Self-Reportingby paying Rs.500/- or Rs.1,000/- (as the case may be) in DOST Candidate Login. The students who are allotted to the Government Degree Colleges/University Colleges and who are eligible, provisionally, for ePASS fee reimbursement (after caste and income certificate verifications) need not pay any amount to reserve the allotted seat, while Online Self-reporting.

- iii. If the candidate fails to reserve the seat through Online Self-Reporting, then the candidate foregoes the seat and his/her registration on DOST shall automatically be cancelled.
- iv. If any candidate is looking for a better choice of seat, he/she can exercise web-options in the next phase by sliding, but after Online Self-Reporting.
- v. The candidate is informed to report to the respective colleges of his/her final choice after Phase-III allotments. If the candidate fails to report to the college, then he/she shall forego the seat allotted.

Phase-III Registrations and Web-options will begin from 29.08.2022 and will go on till 12.09.2022.
