Press Note - DOST-2022 Special Drive Phase Seat Allotment

Prof.R.Limbadri, Convener, DOST & Chairman, TSCHE and Sri. Navin Mittal, IAS, Commissioner, Collegiate Education & SPD-RUSA released the Special Drive Phase seat allotments on DOST-2022-23.

The students who are allotted seats in Special Drive Phase are informed to confirm their seats by online self-reporting from 29.10.2022 to 31.10.2022. They should also confirm their seats by submitting CCOTP in their respective colleges on 31.10.2022, where they self-reported online.

- 1. Total number of candidates allotted in Special Drive Phase: 11,602
- 2. Total number of candidates who gave web-options in Special Drive Phase, 2022: 11,964

Instructions to the candidates:

- i. The candidates who are allotted seats will get SMS to their registered mobiles. The candidates can also get seat allotment details, on demand, through WhatsApp.
- ii. All the candidates who secured a seat are instructed to reserve their seat through Online Self-Reporting by paying Rs.500/- or Rs.1,000/- (as the case may be) in DOST Candidate Login. The students who are allotted to the Government Degree Colleges/University Colleges and who are eligible, provisionally, for ePASS fee reimbursement (after caste and income certificate verifications) need not pay any amount to reserve the allotted seat, while Online Self-reporting.
- iii. If the candidate fails to reserve the seat through Online Self-Reporting, then the candidate foregoes the seat and his/her registration on DOST shall automatically be cancelled.
- iv. The candidates who have self-reported online will get CCOTP through SMS with which they need to confirm in colleges with physical verification.
- v. The self-reporting fee (Rs.500/- or Rs.1000/-) will be adjusted in the respective college fee.
