In this regard, you are kindly requested to direct the concerned authorities at the District level to comply with the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India by way of:

participating in anti-ragging Committees of educational institutions

constituting district level Anti-Ragging committees, to be headed Commissioner/District Magistrate

keeping vigil on incidents of ragging, taking immediate action on receiving distress message from victims of ragging.

You are also requested to kindly take action regarding the following:-3.

appointing State level committees to examine the problems of alcoholism on the campuses and to suggest immediate de-addiction measures

setting up a State level Committee to study the psychological impact of ragging on students and take urgent and mandatory measures to prevent ragging in educational institutions taking e-governance initiatives, e.g. anti-ragging mobile app to check incidents of ragging or eve teasing.


You will also appreciate that there has to be a sustained awareness campaign against ragging, especially through advertisements, throughout the academic year. The State Government may, therefore, consider advising educational institutions in the State to give wide publicity against ragging.
