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

The visit of Prof. V. Visit of European Delegation to Hyderabad: A Step Towards Global Education...



A high-profile delegation from Germany, comprising Indo-Euro Synchronization and IUN Group, met with Prof. V. His academic credentials are exceptional, with an LL.M in International Law from Osmania University, and an M.Phil and Ph.D. in International Air and Space Law from Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU), New Delhi. With over 25 years of teaching and research experience, Prof. Reddy has earned numerous accolades, including the Meritorious State Teachers Award from the Government of Telangana in 2017 and NALSAR's Excellence in Research Award in 2021.

Prof. Reddy has garnered international recognition for his contributions to the field of International Air and Space Law. He has presented research at prestigious forums, including the United Nations, and played a central role in bringing the Institut De Droit International (IDI) to NALSAR for its 78th Session in 2017. This event marked a historic moment as NALSAR became the first institution in India and the second in Asia to host the IDI session in its 150-year history, with participation from over 100 distinguished members from 65 countries.

Beyond his academic and research contributions, Prof. Reddy has been instrumental in shaping Indian policy and legislation. He served as a member of the Drafting Committee for the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO), contributing to key legislative frameworks. His research on the "Transfer of Technology in the Indian Defence Sector: IPR Issues and Challenges" has earned widespread attention for its relevance to the defense sector.

As the Director of the Centre for Aerospace and Defence Laws (CADL), Prof. Reddy has introduced innovative and specialized courses in aviation, space, defense, and maritime laws. Additionally, as the Director of the Centre for Tribal and Land Rights (CTLR), Prof. Reddy has played a critical role in drafting over 100 state legislations in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh, focusing on land rights and justice for marginalized communities.

Prof. Reddy's influence also extends to international legal forums, where he has organized numerous conferences and workshops under the M.K. Nambyar SAARC Law Centre, contributing to the advancement of legal discourse in South Asia. His publications, including books on air law, space law, and aviation, have garnered significant acclaim in the international legal community.

At Mahindra University, Prof. Reddy led numerous academic reforms, including the development of a comprehensive Research Manual, curriculum reforms focused on practical learning, and the establishment of a Legal Aid Cell to support marginalized communities. Under his mentorship, several Ph.D. scholars have completed their doctorates, further cementing his legacy in legal education.

Prof. Toparapu Gangadhar, the current In-charge Vice-Chancellor of Jawaharlal Nehru Architecture and Fine Arts University (JNAFAU), stands as a beacon of excellence in the field of visual arts. With over 36 years of experience, his journey from a passionate student to an eminent artist, educator, and academic leader has been marked by numerous achievements and significant contributions to the arts and education at JNAFAU.

Born in 1965 in Bheemgalmandal, Nizamabad district, Telangana, Prof. Gangadhar's artistic journey began with a 5-year Diploma in Applied Art (1981-1986) and a Master of Fine Arts (Applied Art) from the JNTU College of Fine Arts in Hyderabad. In 1992, he joined the same institution as a lecturer. Over the years, he progressed through the ranks from Assistant Professor (1998) to Associate Professor (2006) and eventually became a Professor in 2022. His passion for mentoring students has helped shape the careers of many aspiring artists, both within the institution and beyond.

Throughout his career, Prof. Gangadhar has contributed to JNAFAU in various teaching and

administrative roles, including serving as the Head of the Applied Arts Department at the College of Fine Arts (2017). He has played a key role in expanding the department, improving infrastructure, and fostering an environment that nurtures artistic talent. Notable initiatives under his leadership include organizing art camps, student art fairs, and annual exhibitions, which have bridged the gap between academia and the broader art community.

In addition to his teaching and administrative accomplishments, Prof. Gangadhar has made significant contributions to public art. He has created iconic sculptures such as the statues of late Sri N.T.
