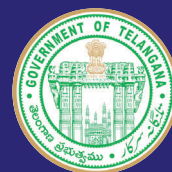

## The Telangana Council of Higher Education (TGCHE) Convened a Meeting with the Vice-Chancellors of Conventional Universities



### The Chairman, TGCHE convened a meeting with the Vice-Chancellors of Conventional Universities

The Telangana Council of Higher Education (TGCHE) convened a meeting with the Vice-Chancellors of Conventional Universities on April 4, 2025, at the TGCHE Conference Hall, under the chairmanship of Prof. V. Balakista Reddy, Chairman, TGCHE, to deliberate on academic and administrative reforms in the higher education landscape of Telangana.

The meeting was attended by Vice-Chancellors of Osmania University, Kakatiya University, Telangana University, Mahatma Gandhi University, Palamuru University, Satavahana University, and Chakali Illamma Women's Univ along with the Vice Chairmen and Secretary of TGCHE.

Several key resolutions were taken to enhance the quality and relevance of higher education in the state:

- **Revamp of UG Curriculum:** A 20% revision of the undergraduate syllabus will be undertaken to incorporate emerging areas such as Artificial Intelligence, Cybersecurity, Fintech, and Research Aptitude. The revised syllabus will be implemented from the academic year 2025-26.
- **Student-Centric and Pedagogical Reforms:** Structured Learning Units will be introduced, and Faculty Development Programs will be rolled out through digital platforms, including a strategic MoU with T-SAT for wider content dissemination.
- **New Assessment Pattern:** A Continuous Assessment Pattern (CAP) with a 100-mark distribution (Project Work/ Assignment – 25, Midterm – 25, End Semester – 50) will be

adopted to ensure ongoing evaluation of students.

- **Common Academic Calendar:** All universities have agreed on a unified academic calendar and final UG examinations to be completed by April 30 each year, allowing smooth conduct of Common Entrance Tests (CETs) in May.
- **Affiliation Process Streamlining:** Deadlines have been fixed for affiliation of Law, Professional, and Degree colleges. Universities have been directed to thoroughly verify the approved intake before granting affiliation, due to noted discrepancies between sanctioned intake and actual admissions.
- **Course Conversion Guidelines:** Conversion of UG courses is considered for A.Y. 2025-26.
- **CPGET 2025:** Osmania University will conduct CPGET 2025 for all PG courses.
- **DOST Admissions:** DOST notification will be released after the declaration of Intermediate results. Hence, all universities have been instructed to upload accurate college and course data on the DOST portal by April 30, 2025.
- The Vice-Chancellors also unanimously agreed for the removal of the existing Bucket System for UG courses and called upon TGCHE to formulate guidelines for monitoring Autonomous Colleges.

The Chairman, TGCHE, Prof. V. Balakista Reddy, thanked all participants and reaffirmed the Council's commitment towards fostering academic excellence, transparency, and innovation in Telangana's higher education sector.



## "Telangana Universities to Focus on Career-Oriented Education : CM Holds Review with Vice Chancellors"

**Chief Minister Emphasizes Student-Centric Approach in Universities Focus on Market-Relevant Courses and Holistic Infrastructure Development**

Hyderabad: In a significant step towards transforming higher education in Telangana, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri A. Revanth Reddy chaired a high-level review meeting with Vice Chancellors of state universities at the Integrated Command and Control Centre (ICCC), Hyderabad. The Chief Minister stressed the need for all universities in the state to function with a student-centric approach, aligning academic offerings with the emerging needs of the job market.

The Chief Minister emphasized that courses with limited relevance must be phased out and replaced with demand-driven and career-oriented programs, particularly in government universities where the majority of students come from economically weaker and rural backgrounds. "Our teaching must pave the way for a brighter future for these students, empowering them to compete with their peers from private universities," he stated.

CM Revanth Reddy pointed out that while private universities are attracting students from financially stronger families with their market-aligned courses, government universities must adapt quickly to offer similar opportunities. He called for restructuring of academic programs, assigning administrative responsibilities to professors associated with obsolete courses, and avoiding turning universities into mere rehabilitation centers for faculty.

During the meeting, Vice Chancellors brought to the CM's attention the pressing issues of faculty shortages, inadequate infrastructure, and funding constraints. In response, the Chief Minister assured them of the government's commitment to allocating necessary funds and directed all universities to prepare detailed reports on their respective needs — including faculty recruitment, building infrastructure, and other academic facilities.

Further, the CM advised that a comprehensive consultation be held with the Government Advisor Shri K. Keshav Rao, following which a consolidated report, along with university-wise action plans, should be submitted to the government for further consideration.

The meeting was attended by key dignitaries including CM's Advisor Shri Venkata Narendar Reddy, Government Advisors Shri K. Keshav Rao and Shri Srinivasa Raju, TSCHE Chairman Prof. R. Limbadri, Principal Secretary to CM Shri Manik Raj, Education Secretary Smt. Yogita Rana, Commissioner of Technical Education Smt. A. Sridevasena, Director of School Education Shri Narasimha Reddy, and several university Vice Chancellors and education commission members.

This meeting marks a pivotal moment in the state's efforts to redefine the role of public universities in fostering inclusive, quality, and employment-oriented higher education in Telangana.

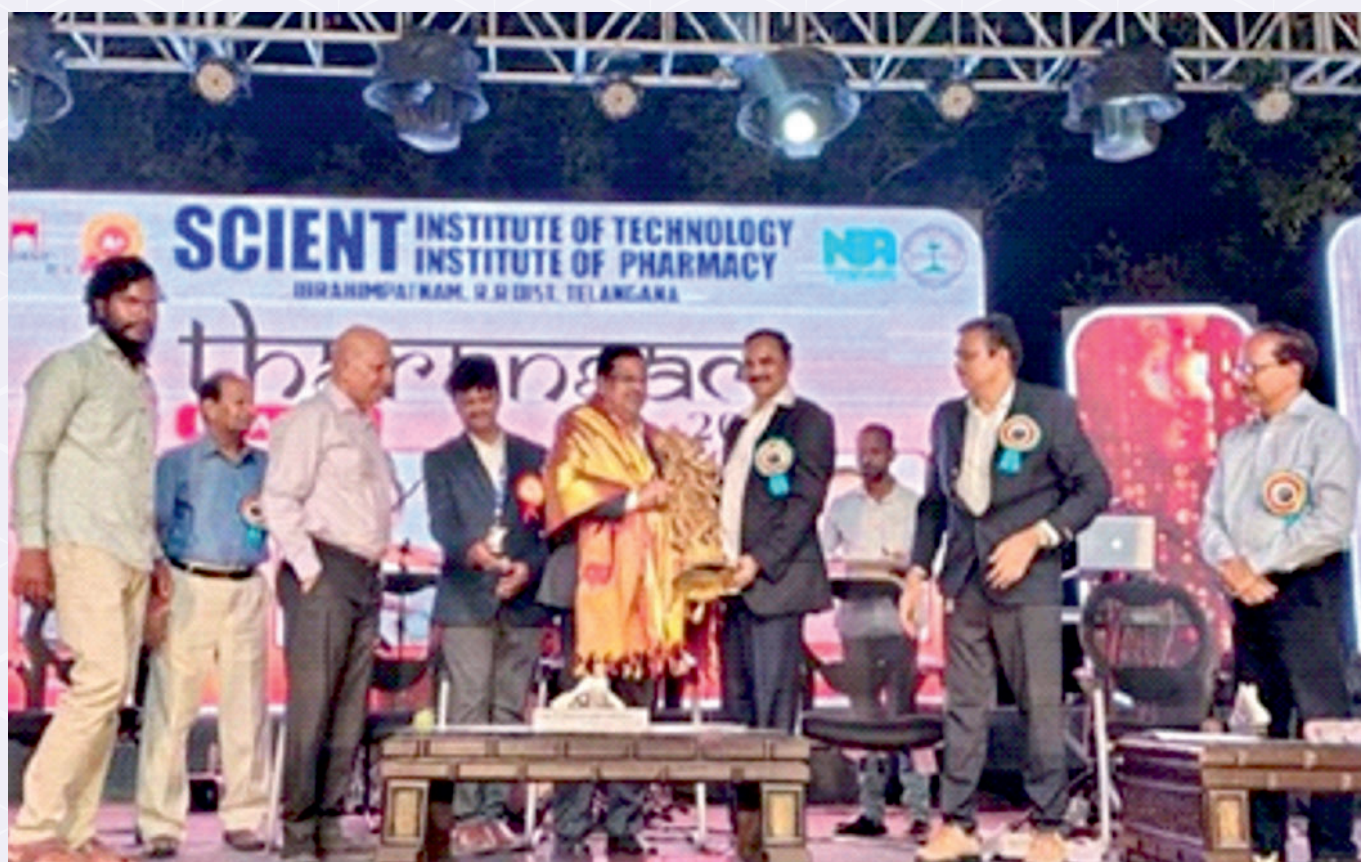

He reiterated TGCHE's commitment to bridging this gap by promoting NEP 2020-aligned reforms, integrating emerging technologies like AI, IoT, and cybersecurity into the curriculum, and encouraging outcome-based learning.

He further underlined the importance of adaptability in the face of the Fourth Industrial Revolution, noting that the next decade will be defined by digital jobs, innovation-driven careers, and lifelong learning. He encouraged students to look beyond degrees, focus on skills, values, and use technology to solve pressing societal problems.

## TGCHE and JNTUH Gear Up for Smooth Conduct of TG EAPCET-2025 Across Telangana



### TGCHE and JNTUH Coordinate for Successful Conduct of TG EAPCET-2025 Across 16 Test Zones in Telangana

Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH), on behalf of the Telangana Council of Higher Education (TGCHE), is conducting the Telangana State Engineering, Agriculture and Pharmacy Common Entrance Test (TG EAPCET-2025) for admissions into first-year undergraduate professional courses across the state on 18.04.2025

The computer-based test (CBT) is scheduled to be conducted in two streams—Engineering and Agriculture & Pharmacy (AP)—as per the following schedule:

A total of 3,05,774 candidates have registered for the exam this year:

- Engineering (E): 2,19,420
- Agriculture & Pharmacy (AP): 86,101
- Both Streams: 253

The exam will be held across 16 test zones with 112 centers for AP and 124 centers for Engineering, ensuring seamless logistics and accessibility for students across Telangana.

#### Important Candidate Instructions

To maintain transparency and fairness in the conduct of the exam, all candidates are required to:

- Report early to test centers (by 07:30 AM for morning and 01:30 PM for afternoon sessions).
- Undergo biometric verification (photograph and thumb impression).
- Avoid Mehendi/tattoos on hands to ensure smooth biometric capture.
- Carry valid ID proof (Aadhaar, Voter ID, Passport, etc.) and a blue/black ballpoint pen.
- Surrender rough sheets after the exam and avoid bringing electronic gadgets or wristwatches.
- Be aware that no entry is allowed even if late by a minute, and no early exit is permitted before the end of the session.

Candidates are also encouraged to review bilingual papers carefully; in case of discrepancies in translation, English will be considered final. Objections to the preliminary key can be raised by paying Rs. 500/- per question, refundable if found valid.

#### Support from Media and Stakeholders

TGCHE and JNTUH expressed their gratitude to the print and electronic media for their consistent support in publicizing the notification and key instructions. Media partners are requested to extend further cooperation by spreading awareness on the guidelines and motivating candidates and parents for a smooth and confident exam experience.

The exam details have been analyzed and compiled into annexures covering test zone applications, reservation categories, gender and board-wise data, and trends from 2018 to 2024.

Highlighting Telangana's proactive steps, Prof. Reddy outlined key initiatives by TGCHE to embed AI and emerging technologies into higher education. These include:

- Integration of AI, ML, and Data Science into UG curricula;
- AI-based skill development initiatives through TASK;
- Collaborations IIT-Hyderabad to drive innovation and applied research;
- Use of T-SAT Network and Digital Classrooms to spread AI literacy across rural Telangana.

Prof. Reddy also commended Government Degree Colleges in the state for embracing AI-enabled platforms and organizing faculty development programs to upskill educators.

He congratulated GDC Ghambiraopet for its leadership in sparking critical academic discourse on AI and for leveraging a hybrid model to ensure inclusive participation. The seminar marked another significant step in Telangana's mission to build a future-ready, AI-empowered education system.

stress effectively. Research from institutions like NIMHANS underscores that unmanaged stress adversely affects memory, learning, and decision-making – directly impacting student outcomes.

### TGCHE Initiatives for Student Well-being

Prof. Reddy shared various initiatives spearheaded by TGCHE to promote mental health and wellness in higher education institutions across Telangana:

- Establishing student counseling centers staffed with trained mental health professionals.
- Organizing faculty development programs to help educators identify early signs of student distress.
- Integrating yoga, mindfulness, and physical activity into daily campus routines.
- Encouraging peer support networks and awareness campaigns to normalize mental health conversations.

He emphasized the need for campuses to transform into wellness-centered ecosystems that foster not just academic rigor, but also emotional strength, adaptability, and lifelong learning.

A Message to Students



Addressing the student community directly, Prof. Reddy said, “Your mental well-being is not secondary to your education – it is foundational to it. Seeking help is not a sign of weakness, but a mark of courage and self-awareness.” He urged students to take proactive steps in prioritizing their mental health alongside academic pursuits.

In conclusion, Prof. Reddy congratulated the seminar organizers for addressing such a timely and impactful theme. He called for a collective effort from educators, administrators, and students to create holistic learning environments where well-being, excellence, and employability go hand-in-hand.





### TGCHE for UG curriculum revision from next year

The Telangana Council of Higher Education (TGCHE) met with Vice-Chancellors of seven conventional universities in the State to deliberate on academic and administrative reforms on Friday. A resolution was passed at the meeting, seeking a revamp of the undergraduate curriculum with 20% revision to incorporate emerging areas of studies such as Artificial Intelligence, Cybersecurity, Fintech, and Research Aptitude. For student-centric and pedagogical reforms, structured learning units will be introduced and faculty development programmes will be rolled out, including an MoU with T-SAT (Telangana Skills, Academic and Training) for wider content dissemination. It was also proposed to assess students through a Continuous Assessment Pattern with a 100-mark distribution divided as 25 marks each for project work and midterm, and 50 marks for end semester. All the course conversion guidelines will come into effect from 2025-26 academic year.

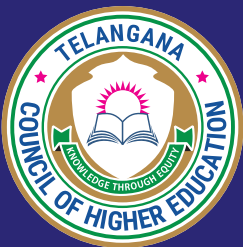
