Guidelines and Schedule for Conducting the Admission Process to Fill up 30% Seats under Management Quota (Category 'B') and 15% Supernumerary Quota in B.E./B.Tech. Courses, and for Submission of Lists of Students for Ratification by the Competent Authority for the Academic Year 2026–27.

The Managements of **Non-Minority/Minority** Private Unaided Engineering Colleges having AICTE recognition & University Affiliation in the State of Telangana are required to follow the Admission Guidelines and Admission Schedule issued as below for conducting the process of admissions to fill up 30% of seats under Management Quota (Category 'B') into B.E./B.Tech Courses for the academic year 2026-27 in a fair, transparent and non-exploitative manner.

Guidelines for conducting Admissions for the academic year 2026-27:

1. The Managements shall adhere to the admission schedule announced by TGCHE given below for the year 2026-27.
2. Notification shall be issued by the Managements of the colleges in **at least Three leading daily Newspapers, One in each language i.e., in English, Telugu & Urdu. It should contain the following details:-**
 - a) Minority/Non-Minority Status of the college
 - b) Management & NRI seats available, branch wise
 - c) Application format
 - d) Application & Registration Fee to be paid and mode of payment
 - e) Tuition fee details
 - f) Last date for submission of application by the candidates
 - g) Mode of submission both Online & In-person
 - h) Venue for collecting application and submission of application form
3. Applying 'Online' by the candidates seeking admission shall be permitted. **The details of college web portal shall be provided.**
 - a) Managements shall entertain all the requisitions made before the last date for supply of application forms in person and shall issue acknowledgement to the applicants registered both online and offline.
 - b) Candidate shall submit duly filled in application form before the last date prescribed for submission to the Managements of the college concerned along with the prescribed registration fee in favour of the Management through Demand Draft / Payment gateway as indicated in the notification.
 - c) Those students who are desirous of applying to other colleges shall do so by submitting separate applications along with registration fees prescribed.
 - d) The filled in application form shall indicate the order of preference of the candidate for different courses offered by the college.
4. Managements shall maintain day wise register for recording the Receipt of Application Forms (candidate name, address, mobile number etc.,) in person.
5. Management shall issue necessary instructions to the candidates with regard to payment of Application & Registration Fee.
6. Eligibility Criteria and order of merit:
 - a) *NRI - The institutions that are approved by All India Council for Technical Education are permitted to fill NRI seats not exceeding 15% of the sanctioned intake in each course for the academic year shall admit NRI / NRI Sponsored candidates who have*

passed the qualifying examination with not less than 50% marks in the prescribed group subjects or 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying examination or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) equivalent to 5 on a 10 Point Scale.

- b) *JEE (Mains) - The Vacant seats from NRI Quota if any remaining 15 % seats the sanctioned intake shall be filled on merit basis with candidates including from other States and Union territories who have secured All India rank at JEE (Mains) following the eligibility criteria prescribed in rule (4) of GO's 74 & 75, Dt:28.07.2011 and secured not less than 45% of marks in the prescribed group subjects in the qualifying examination or equivalent*
- c) *TGEAPCET - The seats remaining unfilled from the above shall be filled with eligible candidates, who have qualified the TGEAPCET-2026 examination on merit basis following eligibility criteria laid in rule (4) of G.O's.74 & 75, Dated 28.07.2011.*
- d) *Thereafter, if any seats still remain unfilled, such seats may be filled on merit basis with candidates securing not less than 45% (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved categories) of marks in the prescribed group subjects taken together/ aggregate marks in the qualifying examinations, as prescribed.*
7. Managements shall prepare combined list of all the applicants, both applications received online and offline (in-person) for each course and shall display the same on web portal and notice board of the college.
8. Separate merit list of applicants shall also be prepared for each course on the basis of NRI Status / JEE (Mains) / TGEAPCET Rank / percentage of marks in the prescribed group subjects taken together/aggregate marks in the qualifying examinations and shall display the same on web portal and notice board of the college.
9. Selection list of candidates for admission against the available seats for each course under Category 'B' admissions, shall be prepared discipline wise following the priorities of category of students (NRI, JEE Mains, TGEAPCET / Marks in the qualifying examination as prescribed in relevant G.O's. and shall display the same on web portal and notice board of the college
10. The Managements of Engineering Colleges shall follow the following schedule for Category B admissions:

i)	Issue of Notification by the Managements of the college in three leading newspapers (Telugu, English, Urdu) and display on the college website as mentioned in item No.2 (Minimum of Seven (7) working days should be given to apply) from the date of Notification	29.06.2026 Onwards
ii)	Last date of Receiving applications	15.07.2026
iii)	Last date of Finalization of admissions	28.07.2026
iv)	Last date for uploading details of Management /(FN/PIO/CIWG) under Supernumerary quota of seats in the web portal without Late fee (Rs.1,000/- per candidate)	29.07.2026
v)	Last date for freezing of uploaded details without late fee & Last date for submission of hard copy	30.07.2026
vi)	Last date for uploading and payment of processing fee with late fee is Rs.3,000/- + Rs.1,000/-, Total per candidate is Rs.4,000/-	05.08.2026
vii)	Last date for freezing of uploaded details with late fee & Last date for submission of hard copies of documents of the candidates admitted	06.08.2026

11. The date of reporting for admission in to the college is to be informed to the selected candidates as per the schedule announced by the college and acknowledgement of the candidate who joined at the college shall be obtained.
12. Vacant seats, if any, from the selection list shall be filled (branch wise) from the merit list of the remaining applicants, which was announced already.
13. Class work of the colleges for the academic year 2026-27 shall commence from the date as informed by the Authority.
14. The detailed instructions for uploading of admitted candidates & payment gateway system through web portal <https://catb.tgche.ac.in>, will be placed in the website in due course of time.
15. The following instructions are to be followed with regard to the admissions.
 - a) The Managements shall scrupulously follow the Government Orders / instructions issued by the Competent Authority for admission of students under different categories. The Managements are held responsible for admissions made in deviation of the rules prescribed by the Government and the decision of the competent authority is final on such issues.
 - b) The Managements shall obtain approval of the admissions made under Category-B seats and 15% supernumerary quota from the Competent Authority only.
 - c) The Managements shall pay verification and processing fee as fixed by the Competent Authority and upload and submit proposals of Management quota admissions as per the schedule prescribed by the Competent Authority.
 - d) The managements shall adhere to the schedule of admissions, uploading and payment of processing fee / late fee /service fee as fixed by the Competent Authority and upload and submit proposals separately for various categories of admissions mentioned above. The cutoff date(s) for submission of admission lists for approval of the Competent Authority shall be the same for the admissions under 15% supernumerary quota.
 - e) The Managements shall:
 - (i) UPLOAD the details of students admitted under Category-B Management Quota through online by logging onto <https://catb.tgche.ac.in>. The detailed user manual / steps for uploading the details of admitted students and payment gateway system is available in the above portal.
 - (ii) Submit the Hard copy of the uploaded list of students admitted under Category-B Management Quota and 15% Supernumerary Quota with signature and seal of the Principal of the College. **(Annexure-I, II & III)**.
 - (iii) Pay the processing fee of **Rs.1,000/-** for each candidate through payment gateway system available in the <https://catb.tgche.ac.in>.
 - f) The Managements shall indicate their email ID, contact Phone Numbers and complete postal address on the letter head of the College. The Managements shall note that if their letter head does not specify the aforementioned details, the address of the College will not be considered as valid.
 - g) The Managements shall submit the hard copy of the uploaded details, proof of payment of processing fee and relevant documents duly enclosing index with page numbers as per the serial order of uploaded details so as to avoid the complaints on the submission of documents by the Managements.
 - h) Submission of documents without visibility of letters, PDF, Image formats etc., will not be entertained and such submissions will be treated as deliberate and irresponsible on the part of the Management and such actions attract fine on the Managements.

- i) The Managements shall not be permitted to alter / replace / add the name of the candidates once the details are uploaded by the Management and submitted in the form of hard copy.
- j) The Managements will not be allowed to upload or submit admission lists in a phased manner. If the Managements resort to such submissions, it will be construed that the College has made admissions beyond the closure / cut-off date and such admissions will not be ratified. They shall upload the details and submit the proposal only once to the Competent Authority.
- k) The managements shall submit all the relevant documents required for processing and verification. In case, there are any deficiencies due to incomplete submission of documents, the Managements can get them rectified by submitting the required documents only once.
- l) If any Management fills the seats under 15% supernumerary quota without following the procedure as mentioned in G.O Ms. No.49 Higher Education (EC/A2) Department dated 25.06.2013 or without approval of seats from AICTE, such Managements shall abide by the decision taken by the Competent Authority on such admissions.
- m) The Managements are required to submit the proposals in person in the inward section of the TGCHE in accordance with the cut off dates prescribed and obtain acknowledgement.
- n) The Managements are required to submit the following along with the applications for approval of TGCHE:
 - i) Paper Advertisement in Original (Telugu, English, Urdu).
 - ii) Maintenance of register for Day Wise sale of applications
 - iii) Application form provided through online & offline mode
 - iv) AICTE approval to admit NRI Candidates, if any
 - v) Merit list of eligible applications as per rule 6 (ii)2(v) G.O.Ms.No.74
 - vi) Separate Merit List of Candidates applied (Branch wise)
 - a) NRI
 - b) Management
 - vii) Selection list of candidates in each Branch (1st, 2nd, 3rd..... etc.,)
 - a) NRI
 - b) Management
 - viii) List of NRI Students applied and admitted
 - ix) List of Other State students applied and admitted
 - x) No. of Left-over seats remaining, and filled with eligible candidates
 - xi) Dates of Interviews conducted to the Applicants
 - xii) List of rejected candidates after Interviews with reasons
 - xiii) Undertaking by the Principal/Secretary of the College (**Annexure-II**)
 - xiv) Original Payment Receipt
- o) The Managements of the colleges are required to submit online and in person the following Original Certificates of the admitted candidates at the time of verification of each admitted student are as follows:
 - TG EAPCET-2026 Rank Card / JEE Rank Card with Hall Ticket
 - SSC/10th Class Marks Memo
 - Intermediate /Diploma Marks Memo
 - Study certificates from 6th to Intermediate

- Intermediate/Diploma Transfer Certificate
- Community certificate (In case of SC/ST/BC)
- Equivalency Certificate from BIE /AIU (in case of students who passed the qualifying examination from other states and other countries.)

Note:-

- 1. The Managements are advised to comply with the Government Orders / Council Guidelines and schedule while admitting the students particularly from other board/universities.**
- 2. The Candidates should have passed Maths, Physics & Chemistry in CBSE examination or by any other examination Boards.**
